Educator Field Study Grades 5–12 United States Holocaust Memorial Museum (USHMM) in Washington D.C.

Travel Dates: Friday, February 5–Saturday, February 6, 2027

Applications will be reviewed on receipt. Incomplete submissions will not be considered. The final deadline for application submission is Monday, October 26, 2026.

Capacity is limited, and previous participants are ineligible.

Selection Preference

Preference will be given to applicants who have previously participated in programs or professional development offered by the Gutterman Family Center for Holocaust and Human Rights Education. **Participants will be required to attend the November 14th Professional Development.**

Costs and Responsibilities

Airfare and lodging will be covered for participants who are current educators. Participants are responsible for their own meals, local transportation, and incidental expenses.

Educators traveling to the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum (USHMM) must demonstrate a clear, sustained connection to our mission. This opportunity is not a one-time experience or simply a “trip”. It is part of an ongoing professional and educational commitment and does not end upon the conclusion of travel.

Participation carries an expectation of continued engagement — bringing learning back to the classroom, collaborating with colleagues, and remaining actively connected to the Gutterman Family Center and its educational goals.

Notification and Registration

Applicants will be notified of acceptance or rejection via email. Accepted applicants receive a registration link with payment instructions. The registration fee is refundable if the eligibility requirements are met.

Confirmation of participation will be issued once all required documentation has been submitted by the stated deadline. Cancellations initiated by participants will result in forfeiture of the registration fee.

Program Requirements

- Attendance at both, the mandatory virtual pre-trip session on Thursday, January 28, 2027, and the post-trip session (TBD) is required.
- The pre-Field Study assignment must be completed prior to travel.
- The post-Field Study assignment must be completed immediately after travel.
- The follow-up implementation must be submitted after the trip, such as a lesson plan or presentation, clearly outlined and timely.
- This Field Study requires significant walking and standing.
- The weather will be cold, so appropriate clothing is required.
