A DISTINGUISHED FACULTY

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

The Ph.D. program requires a minimum of 48 credits of approved course work beyond the master's degree, plus 9 credit hours for the dissertation, for a total of 57 credit hours.

PROGRAM DEADLINES AND STIPENDS

Competitive stipends are available at \$26,400 plus 80%-100% tuition reimbursement for full-time students.

- Application deadlines are November 1 and April 1 for domestic students and February 15 and August 15 for international students.
- Admission is open to both full and part-time students.

TEACHING, RESEARCH AND PUBLICATION OPPORTUNITIES

A unique feature of the Ph.D. program is the teaching opportunity provided to qualified students, who earn the privilege of teaching one or more undergraduate courses while pursuing the Ph.D. Through faculty mentoring and working on research assignments with faculty members, students develop strong research skills and self-confidence. Numerous doctoral students have authored or coauthored articles and book chapters prior to completing their degrees. Also, students frequently make presentations at professional conferences and submit manuscripts for refereed journals. FAU is among the nation's top-ranked programs in student-faculty collaborations in public affairs.
