By the date of application, the applicant must be a full time student in good standing with the program and with a minimum 3.5 GPA. The applicant must submit a short, one page statement of purpose stating how he or she would use the grant, a copy of his or her unofficial transcript, and letter of support from a professor or advisor. Awardees will be selected by the College Scholarships Committee. Applicants will be notified by the end of April.
