IMPORTANT NOTES
All major courses must be completed with a minimum grade of "C".
The total major credits are 33 (including SYG 1000). If SYD 3792 is taken in place of SYG 1000, the major is granted with 30 major credits.

A minimum of 120 credits is required, 60 of which must be earned at a senior institution.

FAU Foreign Language Requirement: Students in the Dorothy F. Schmidt College of Arts and Letters must demonstrate proficiency in a foreign language (two semesters or CLEP exam). If not completed prior to enrollment, 8 out-of-discipline credits must be used to fulfill this requirement.

Health, Health Care and Social Services Concentration: Minimum of 12 credits from the concentration list with a grade of C+ or better in each course.

Honors Program: Available to students with a 3.5+ overall GPA and 3.7+ in Sociology (minimum 12 sociology credits completed). See advisor for details.
