The Dance Minor requires a minimum of 18 credits, 9 of which must be upper division courses. All courses used to fulfill the minor, must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.

NOTE: Transfer students seeking a Minor in Dance may apply *equivalent* lower level courses only (Level 1), toward their minor. *Equivalence* will be determined by the student's academic advisor in the Department of Theatre and Dance. At least 75 percent of all credits required for the minor must be earned at FAU. A minimum of nine credit hours must be unique to the minor and may not be used to satisfy requirements in the major.

NOTE: In order to enroll in an upper division elective course, students must have taken the appropriate course prerequisites or have received permission from the instructor.
