RESEARCH INTEREST

The information gathered through research into diverse subjects provides content for an on-going investigation of narrative structures. This investigation focuses on using traditional print techniques, letterpress, offset lithography, silkscreening, as well as digital printing, to produce editioned artist books. Non-traditional book formats and binding techniques are explored as content directs the form of the book work.

Content for the narrative book arts pieces comes from an interest in unusual morsels of information, folktales and traditions of worldly cultures, stories relayed word of mouth and interesting facts lost or forgotten. When these morsels of information are strung together in a narrative or book format they form a gestalt or juxtaposition of visual and verbal information which may not have otherwise been connected.

Recent works have involved working with the following mediums: Vandercook Letterpress, photopolymer plates, wood and lead hand set type; photomontage and projected collage as a method of image manipulation; experimentation with printing on hand made papers using letterpress, laser or inkjet printers; and hand crafted artist books using non-traditional materials and bindings
