

Atlantic Center for the Arts Announces the 22nd Annual University Student Exhibition

CALL FOR STUDENT ARTISTS (**application deadline - April 1, 2011**)

The Annual University Student Exhibition, now in its 22nd year, will be held from **June 25 – August 27, 2011**. We invite all Florida state university art departments in the visual arts to submit **three outstanding students** to be considered for this group exhibition. This annual program is intended to benefit promising young artists pursuing educational goals by exhibiting their work at a prestigious art institute, as well as by having their work juried by an Atlantic Center for the Arts Master Artist-in-Residence. This year's Juror is **Rob Pruitt**.

Eligibility

All full-time students currently enrolled in a degree-seeking program in a state university, who are of junior or senior status during 2011, are eligible. **Post-baccalaureate students are not eligible.**

The exhibition is open to all media.

What materials do the students submit to their department?

Each applicant's folder must contain the following:

- Artist's statement
- Brief educational resume, address, phone number and e-mail
- Up to ten digital images on a disk (readable by both Macintosh and PC) with name, date, title of work, size and medium (image details may be included on the image file or on an accompanying document)
- Multi-media and video works may be submitted on DVD

When is the deadline to receive materials?

Materials must be **received** in the Visual Arts and Art History Dept. office, AH 118, by **Friday, April 1, 2011**.

Announcement of final selection

ACA will notify all students of the **juror's selections by May 10, 2011**.

Delivery of work must be prearranged and received at ACA by 5 PM Monday, June 20, 2011.

ACA will coordinate with each selected student, which works will be exhibited. **Each student will receive \$150 stipend for shipping their work and/or travel expenses.** Insurance for shipping the art will be the responsibility of the artist. Insurance during the exhibition will be the responsibility of ACA.

An opening reception will be held on Friday June 24, 2011 from 5 to 7 PM.

Overnight accommodations for the reception may be available at ACA upon request.
