PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION

Review list of potential new degree programs for Florida Atlantic University for the 2006-2013 academic period.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On July 25, 2006, R.E. LeMon, Vice Chancellor of Academic and Student Affairs of the Florida Board of Governors, requested that each university provide a list of new degree programs it expects to implement within the next seven years. The list, while not binding, was to assist the Board of Governors with its strategic planning process and in scheduling review of professional and doctoral programs.

The list of new degree programs for Florida Atlantic University is based on a preliminary assessment of need based on our strategic plan, national and regional job markets, student demand and program availability at other institutions of higher education. It is anticipated that each program will undergo extensive scrutiny before a new degree program is proposed. This list of potential new degree programs may be revised on an annual basis, with implementation based, in part, on the availability of existing and future resources.

This list was submitted to the Vice Chancellor of Academic and Student Affairs in time meet the August 31, 2006 deadline, after review by the Provost and the President.

SUBJECT: List of New Degree Programs under Consideration

In order to have an understanding of planned degree program expansion, the Chancellor has asked that each university provide a list of new degree programs it expects to implement within the next seven years (up to 2013). This list should include all program levels and the year in which they are most likely to be considered by the University Board of Trustees.

This list is not binding, nor will it be formally considered by the Board of Governors. It is expected that the list will provide our office with the level of information we need to report that the universities are responding to the State University System Strategic Plan goals for degree production. Furthermore, our understanding of institutional aspirations will be critical in working with the Board as its Strategic Planning Committee enters the next phase of its process associated with system structure, facilities planning, and expanding access. Finally, the list will be used for scheduling professional and doctoral programs for consideration by the Board of Governors, and your assistance in this matter by August 31, 2006 will allow us to reinitiate that process.
