Audit & Compliance Committee Draft Minutes

February 1, 2022

AC: A-M. Roll Call and Approval of the November 16, 2021 Meeting Minutes

AC: I-1. Review of Audits: FY22-A-01, Performance Based Funding Data Integrity as of November 30, 2021

Mr. Reuben Iyamu, Inspector General, presented the item. Mr. Iyamu said this is submitted to the Board of Governors every year. There were no major issues.

AC: I-2. Final Follow-Up Audit on NCAA Compliance – Financial Aid (#FY22-A-02)

a. HBOI Foundation Inc.

He said the auditors noted no material weakness, although the audit is not designed to identify all of these issues. One matter was reported that was not material. It related to the protect the wildlife dolphin grant. It does not allow for the reimbursement of administrative costs to subrecipients. FAU is a subrecipient.
