SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION 2.006, INSTITUTES AND CENTERS

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve proposed amendments to Regulation 2.006.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The University seeks to amend Regulation 2.006, Institutes and Centers. The purpose of this amendment is to reflect compliance with the updated requirements of Board of Governors (BOG) Regulation 10.015, Institutes and Centers. The proposed changes are summarized as follows:

- 1. Removes definitions, reporting deadlines and reviews either duplicate of BOG Regulation 10.015 or no longer applicable.
- 2. Updates the procedures and responsibilities for establishing, evaluating, reviewing, and disbanding University institutes and centers.
- 3. Adds language to include a suspension plan for reactivation or termination for an institute or center, as applicable.
- 4. Adds procedures for changing the name or purpose of an institute or center.
- 5. Updates the final authority to the Vice President for Research, in consultation with the Provost or applicable unit Vice President.

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN/DATE

The proposed amended regulation will be implemented and effective upon adoption by the Board of Trustees.
