BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Purpose of Action:

Per Florida Statute 1004.28(3), except for the directors appointed by the Chair of the University's Board of Trustees or designated by the University President, the Board of Trustees approves all appointments of directors to the boards of directors of the University's direct-support organizations, including the Foundation. Ms. Taylor was unanimously elected for appointment by the Foundation's Board of Directors at its December 10, 2025, meeting.

Allison Taylor is an accountant/audit partner at Deloitte in Palm Beach County. She has worked with the company for over two decades.
