QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE CAMPUS RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD

1. Candidates should possess a broad knowledge of Campus Recreation programs, facilities and services. Experiences such as membership or leadership in Club Sports, participation and/or leadership in Intramural Sports, fitness programs and use of the Recreation & Fitness Center shall be considered evidence of knowledge of department offerings.
2. The Campus Recreation Advisory Board Selection Committee will consider and assess candidates' ability to reflect and represent the diversity of the student body at large, the FAU community and the wide range of students served through Campus Recreation.
3. Candidates must maintain a cumulative 2.7 or higher GPA, be enrolled as a degree seeking student and be enrolled a minimum of 6 credit hours, if an undergraduate student or 3 credit hours, if a graduate student.
4. The Campus Recreation Advisory Board Selection Committee will consider and assess candidates' ability to commit to time, effort and involvement necessary to fulfill the Advisory Board responsibilities, as well as evidence of personal commitment to their involvement in the University experience.

The Campus Recreation Advisory Board is a standing committee of Florida Atlantic University, appointed annually by the Vice President for Student Affairs.

The Selection Committee will provide a list of qualified individuals to the Student Government Student Body President who will recommend the student members to the Vice President of Student Affairs.

DUTIES OF THE CAMPUS RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD

1. Propose policies to the Vice President of Student Affairs through the Director of Campus Recreation regarding the overall operation of the Department of Campus Recreation.
2. Review, develop and recommend budget proposals for funding facilities, staff, programs and other services provided by the Department of Campus Recreation.
3. Be accountable to the University students and Rec Members for assessing the physical plant of the department; assessing needs for facility upgrades, additions or enhancements; and reviewing the equitable allocation of space to best serve the needs of the students.
4. Ensure that discussion and review of major programs within the Department of Campus Recreation occurs prior to implementation.
