



# FANTASY FOOTBALL

*Any rules or play interpretations not discussed below will be at the discretion of FAU IM Sports staff.*

## **I. GENERAL**

### **A. Roster Restrictions**

- i. There are no roster restrictions for Intramural Fantasy Football.

### **B. Who is Eligible?**

- i. Current FAU Students
- ii. Those with a membership to FAU Campus Recreation

## **II. Timing**

- A. Intramural Fantasy Football will take place throughout the duration of the 2019-2020 NFL season. This will encompass the entire fall semester and part of Winter Break.

## **III. Regulations**

### **A. The Game**

- i. Each participant may only create one fantasy football team.
- ii. Each league will consist of 8-12 participants
  1. Additional leagues will be created according to registration demand
- iii. In order to enter the league, you must first register for a spot on [IMLeagues.com/FAU](http://IMLeagues.com/FAU)
  1. Once a team has been created and added to a league, a link will be sent out to that team inviting them to join an ESPN league.
  2. When joining the ESPN league, participants must name their team the same name as that on IMLeagues.
- iv. The drafts for each league will be set at the same time. If a league would like to adapt their scheduled draft time, it must be agreed on by 3/4<sup>th</sup> of the participants in the league.
  1. Any participant not eligible to draft at their scheduled time will have their team auto-drafted.
- v. To ensure parity among all participants, no league scoring settings may be altered.
- vi. Play will take place on a weekly basis, with points being accumulated by players throughout the week.
  1. It is up to participants to set their lineups each week. Reminder emails are a courtesy and will not always be sent by Intramural Sports Staff
- vii. The champion of each league, as well as the team with the highest point total at the end of the regular season among all leagues, will receive Intramural Sports championship t-shirts.

#### **IV. SPORTSMANSHIP**

- A.** FAU Campus Recreation's sportsmanship policy has been developed to protect the safety and equity of all participants and those affiliated with supervising our events. The Intramural staff reserves the right to end any intramural contest at any point, or to remove a participant from play.
  - i. Any player that is ejected for any reason must come in to speak to a Competitive Sports professional staff member before their next game. That player or team is **not** eligible to play until doing so. Team will forfeit their ensuing game if the ejected player does not comply with this policy.
