HOW TO ENABLE ALLY IN YOUR COURSE


Ally is a tool that assists in assessing and fixing accessibility issues within your Canvas courses. The steps below will guide you to enable the Ally Accessibility Report for your course to help you analyze and fix any issues that Ally identifies with your course content.

ENABLE ZOOM IN YOUR COURSE

1. After opening a course, click on the **Settings** link in the Course Navigation Menu.



2. Click on the **Navigation** tab at the top of the Settings page.
3. Locate the **Accessibility Report** menu item in the bottom half of the page.
4. Enable the **Accessibility Report** item by performing **one** of the following steps:
 - A. Click and drag the item from the Disabled Items list (bottom) into the Enabled Items list (top).
 - B. Click the ellipsis (three-dots) to the right of the item and click **+ Enable**.
5. Click the blue **Save** button at the bottom of the page.
6. Upon returning to your course's home page, you will see the **Accessibility Report** link in the navigation menu.
