



# CREATE A LINKEDIN LEARNING ASSIGNMENT

The LinkedIn Learning (LIL) integration in Canvas simplifies the process of incorporating LIL content in your courses and using them for assignments and supplemental content. This process is the same as adding other External Tool assignments in Canvas and includes auto-grading functionality. LIL will pass back a grade to Canvas once your students have finished watching the content videos from the assignment in their entirety.

## CREATE A LINKEDIN LEARNING EXTERNAL TOOL ASSIGNMENT

1. Log into <https://canvas.fau.edu>
2. Navigate to a course where you would like to add the LinkedIn Learning assignment.
3. Click the **Assignments** link in the navigation menu.
4. Click the **+Assignment** button at the top-right of the page.
5. Scroll down to the **Submission Type** area and click the dropdown menu.
6. Select **External Tool**.
7. Click the **Find** button.
8. In the list of tools, find and click **LinkedIn Learning**.
9. In the panel that appears, search for the content that you want to integrate and click the **Add** button. You can repeat this for other pieces of content as well.
10. Click the blue **Confirm** button when you have found everything you want to bring into this assignment.
11. Click the **Select** button. This will automatically update the assignment name, instructions, and points settings for you. However, you can still customize those at will.
12. Finalize the rest of the assignment settings and click the **Save** or **Save & Publish** button when you are done.

After saving the assignment it will refresh, and you will see the content that you selected from LinkedIn. Students will be automatically graded upon completely watching the videos from the selected content.
