QUICK STUDENT ANALYTICS IN CANVAS

Canvas's **New Analytics** tool provides a few types of information regarding your students' performance in your course. With just a few clicks you can see what they've been up to and how they're doing in your course. The tool is also set up to communicate with students for a variety of circumstances. ACCESS THE NEW ANALYTICS TOOL

You can access the **New Analytics** tool in three easy steps:

- 1. Log in to https://canvas.fau.edu.
- 2. From your Canvas Dashboard, click on a course whose analytics data you would like to see.
- 3. On the course's **Home** page, click on the

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button on the right of bottom of the page.

STUDENT SUMMARY TABLE (STUDENTS TAB)


New Analytics provides a useful and sortable summary table in the **Students** tab. It can be sorted by clicking on the headers above each column.

1. From your course's **Home** page, click

the New Analytics button in the right or bottom of the page.

Students

- Clickthe tab at the top of the page.
- Clickthe headers (e.g., Grade, Participation, etc.) to sort the table by the data in their respective columns.



From here:

- View students' grades and how that correlates to their activity in the course.
- Clicka student's name to view a detailed breakdown of their activity in your course.
- Click the button to open a tool to send a message to students using a variety of filters. The filters in this tool will change depending on the data that you're viewing (e.g., Weekly Online Activity, Course Grade, individual student, etc.).
- Clickthe button to download this data.
