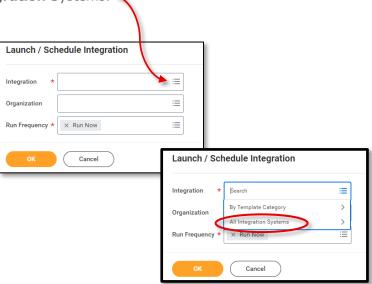
At times journal entries require numerous accounting lines that would be very time consuming to enter line by line. Workday offers the Enterprise Interface Builder (EIB) tool, which allows for mass loading of data through a scheduled integration.

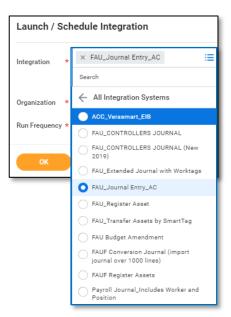
1. In the Workday search field, type **Launch** and hit Enter. Select **Launch / Schedule Integration** from the search results.



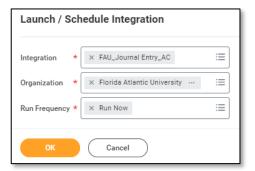
2. In the Integration field, click the drop-down icon and select All **Integration** Systems.



3. Select FAU_Journal Entry_AC in the drop-down list.

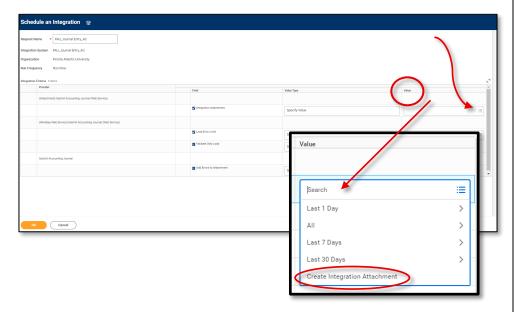


4. In the Organization field, enter Florida Atlantic University. In the Run Frequency field, leave the default **Run Now** selected.



5. Click OK.

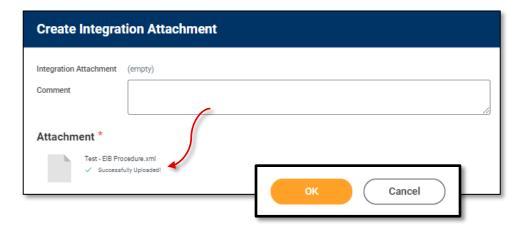
6. The **Schedule an Integration** window opens. Determine the integration criteria by clicking the Dropdown List icon in the Value Field. Select Create Integration Attachment from the list.



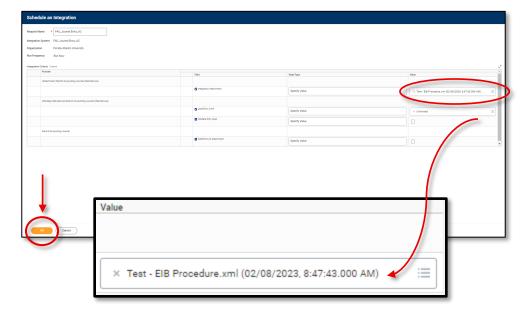
- 7. The Create Integration Attachment window opens. You can use the **Select files** icon to attach your Excel file (.xml file type) through Windows Explorer or drag and Drop your file into the Attachment box.
 - **TIP**: The Excel file must be *closed* before attaching.



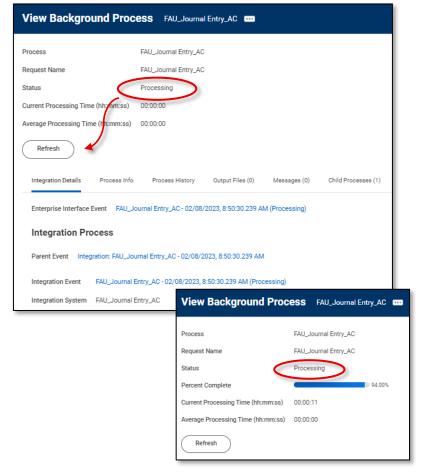
8. If the file upload is successful, click **OK**.



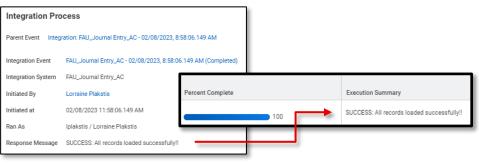
9. The Schedule an Integration window opens again, and the Attachment Value field will now be populated with the attached Excel file. Click OK.



10. Once the integration begins, the View Background Process window will open. Click **Refresh** to see the processing progress.



11. If the Response message is successful, proceed with submitting the journal.

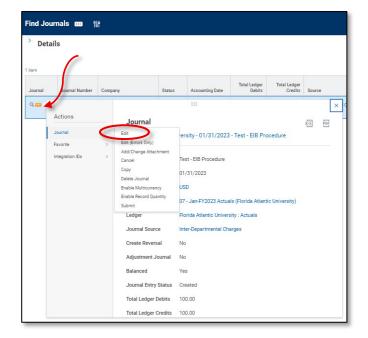


12. A journal is created through the integration process. Run the Find Journals report to find the created journal and open the journal to edit.



13. Click on the **Related Actions** button to open the **Actions** menu. Click **Edit** and proceed with the applicable steps in the **Create a Journal** job aid. The journal lines will be pre-populated with the information that was entered on the EIB Excel file that was loaded during the integration process.

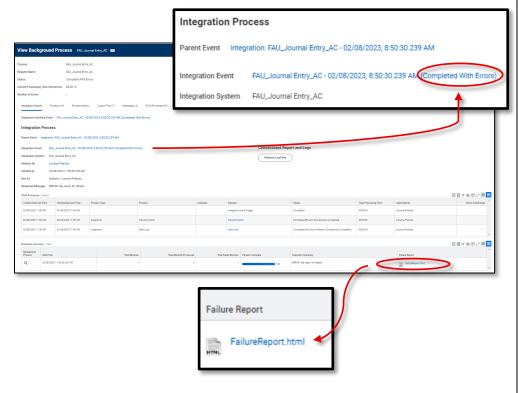
TIP: Review the journal lines and journal header fields and attach the supporting document(s) before submitting.







14. If the Response message indicates an error, an Exception Summary will appear.



15. Click on the FailureReport.html link to download the report. The file will open as a webpage.

16. Click on the **View Details** tabs to open **Error Message** section.



18. Identify the errors with the uploaded EIB and correct as necessary.



19. Once all errors are corrected, repeat steps 1-10.
