- 1. The instructor will meet with the student to discuss the academic integrity issue.
- 2. If the instructor believes the student engaged in dishonesty, the instructor will provide the student written notice of the charge and the sanction.
- 3. Student may request a meeting with the Department Chair and Professor within 5 days of receipt of the notice of charge and sanction, to discuss the facts of the case.

1st offense

Peer counseling with the Dean of Students Office (email: studentconduct@fau.edu; Bldg. 8, 2nd floor of the breezeway, room 226, (561)297-3542) Once completed, notation of the violation is expunged from the student official transcript.

Appeal the Dean of the College

Faculty-Student Council Hearing

Appeal to Provost (Final University Action)

2nd offense

Even if notation of an earlier violation had been expunged from the official transcript, the student will be expelled.
