An Executive Summary of the 2021 Masters in Reading Education Program Completer Satisfaction Survey

The purpose of this Executive Summary is to present the findings from the 2021 College of Education's Completer Satisfaction Survey, seeking input from FAU Masters in Reading Education completers as listed in the eIPEP Final Employment Data 2019-2020 list with DOE Code 212. As required by the Florida Department of Education, this annual survey was conducted during the Fall 2021 semester.

Participants

FAU Completers invited to participate include those in Brevard, Broward, Calhoun, Flagler, Martin, Nassau, Okeechobee, Orange, Palm Beach, and Volusia counties (n=37). The completers ranged from 2012-13 to 2018-19. All participants stated that their employment is in a public school/school district. Participants were also asked to identify the level of students they serve.

Elementary School: 4
Middle School: 1
High School: 2
School District: 1
Other (not identified): 1

Methods

The Florida Department of Education provides a Final Employment List that is available in the eIPEP. The final employment list included those completers between 2012-13 to 2018-19, who were employed in a public school in 2019-20. A Qualtrics survey was emailed to the program completers (n=45) requesting their participation in the online survey; however, nine (9) email addresses were invalid yielding a survey distribution of n=37. On a five-point scale, the Likert-designed survey asked completers to evaluate their effectiveness, as a graduate of the masters in reading education program, in relation to learning and application strategies, overall performance, technological preparation, cultural diversity preparation, advancement of student reading education, job preparation, and overall satisfaction of the survey. The responses are to help serve as a guide in the development of practices for future program planning. The survey was conducted in August to September 2021. The number of responses at the conclusion of the response window was 8, a 21.6% response rate

Data Analysis

The quantitative data format allowed for reliability analysis and descriptive statistics to determine reliability of responses and overall effectiveness as perceived by the completer.

Findings

Based on the Cronbach's Alpha value .944, the results of this pilot and initial distribution show excellent internal consistency. The content is valid based on multiple revisions and email communications to develop the survey with the Masters in Reading Education subject matter experts and the Office of Accreditation, Assessment, and Analytics.

The overall findings portray satisfaction among FAU Masters in Reading Education completers. These data indicated a concern with overall performance in instructional design and lesson planning and cultural diversity pedagogy for a diverse K-12 student body. The areas that excelled included determining appropriate learning and application strategies, educational relevance for job preparation, and overall satisfaction with the program. The specifics for these findings are presented in the following tables and summaries. Aggregate data and descriptive statistics tables follow these findings.

Mean Rating Summaries

Table 1 demonstrates the mean ratings of the completer perceptions of FAU completers who were employed in 2019-20 in each of the categories. The mean ratings lean toward strong agreement among participants that the FAU Masters in Reading Education program prepares "very effective" completers in the categories of Overall Program Satisfaction (4.75), Ability to Advance Student Reading Education (4.50), Learning and Application Strategies (4.44), Job Preparation (4.38), and Overall performance on Various Skills (4.10). The two categories that had mean that leaned towards "moderately effective" are Cultural Diversity (3.88) and Technology Preparation (3.63).

Percentage Rating Summaries

Table 2 and 3 demonstrates the FAU completers perceptions who were employed in 2019-20. The highest scored rating scale for every category was extremely effective. The lowest scored scale chosen was not at all effective for two questions: Overall Performance on Various Skills: 1. Applying concepts from reading education and learning theories in instructional design and lesson planning, and Cultural Diversity: 2. Implementing appropriate pedagogy that benefits a diverse K-12 student body. Overall, the completers overall program satisfaction was rated excellent (75.00%) and good (25.00%).
