How to Stay Safe Online While Traveling

Be Cautious with Public Wi-Fi:

- Avoid public Wi-Fi when logging into any financial websites or data sensitive systems
- Connect to your personal hotspot from your phone or connect to a VPN first, if you must connect to financial or data sensitive systems.

Secure Your Devices:

- Enable auto-lock, strong passcodes, and Find My Device.
- Keep software and antivirus up to date.

Backup Before You Go:

- Back up important files to a secure cloud storage or onto an encrypted drive.

Watch out for Phishing & Scams:

- Be skeptical of “urgent” travel or security messages.
- Look at the full email address, not just the name, before opening any links or opening attachments to help ensure it is a legitimate email.

Social Media Awareness:

- Don't post real-time location updates — share photos after returning.
- Review your privacy settings.

Protect Personal & Institutional Data:

- Avoid accessing or downloading information that is confidential or sensitive on shared public devices.
- Log out of all accounts after use.
