Primary Materials:

- _____ 1. **Graduate Application** (<http://www.fau.edu/graduate>)
- _____ 2. **Application Fee** (payable online)
- _____ 3. **Official transcripts** from all undergraduate and graduate programs
- _____ 4. **Official scores on the GRE** which include Verbal, Quantitative and the (new) Analytic section. Although the GRE is required, there are no minimum sub-score requirements. Scores may not be more than five years old. *Note: Transmit scores to Florida Atlantic University institution code of 5229. Official scores can take up to 2 weeks to be submitted. Plan accordingly to ensure they are received by the application deadline.*
- _____ 5. **Official test scores on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)** (International students only)

Supplementary Materials:

- _____ 1. **Professional resume or vita** which reflects at least three years of related experience.
- _____ 2. **Statement of objectives** describing academic training, related work experience (3 years minimum), and professional goals. This statement should be 2-3 pages.
- _____ 3. **Three letters of recommendation on professional letterhead** attesting to suitability for graduate study and entry into the field of professional counseling. *Note: Our department does **not** accept the "Letter of Recommendation Form" in lieu of a letter.*

All items must be submitted through the Graduate College's GradCas portal.
