THE PROGRAM

The MASTER'S DEGREE in ELEMENTARY EDUCATION WITH ESOL PLUS CERTIFICATION is designed for students holding a bachelor's degree who intend on becoming Elementary Teachers (K-6). Upon program completion, which includes student teaching, the student is eligible for Florida Professional Certification and an M.Ed. in Elementary Education.
