Higher Education Leadership Course Rotation¹**

WORKING DRAFT January 2020
Spring 2020 – Fall 2023

This course rotation is for advising purposes only and is subject to change.

Leadership Core

- *Lead I**, *Lead II* and *Lead III* are offered fall, spring and summer semesters in varied delivery formats (Saturday, weekday, online). *HEL students have the option of taking Lead I and/or Student Development Theory (EDH 6040) to satisfy the leadership core requirement.
- *LEAD V* is offered in Fall on Wednesday and Spring on Saturday (first half) in Boca Raton.
- *LEAD VI* is offered in Fall on Saturday (first half) and Spring on Wednesday in Boca Raton.
- Note some core sections are taught by HEL faculty.

Research Methods

- *Statistics* and research methods courses are routinely offered, fall, spring and summer in varied delivery formats. Doctoral level courses, Advanced Statistics and Advanced Educational Research, are usually offered in Boca Raton on a weekday, often Wednesdays, fall and spring. When possible, courses are offered during the summer.
- *Introduction to Qualitative Inquiry* is offered fall, spring and summer semesters. (Varies across Boca, Jupiter and Davie, executive track and weekday) Fall in Boca on Saturdays for executive track, second half of term. Spring rotates between Davie (odd years) and Jupiter (even years) for traditional weekday format. Summer in Boca Raton on weekday (Tuesdays and Thursdays). An additional section may be available based on cohort demand.
- *Advanced Qualitative Inquiry* is offered twice a year (fall and spring). Offered fall semester in Boca Raton on a weekday (Wednesday). Offered spring semester in Davie on a weekday (even years only) and offered in in Jupiter on a weekday (odd years only).

¹ *Students should contact their respective advisors for guidance regarding courses and individual programs of study. A Program of Study (POS) should be developed the first semester in consultation with an advisor. Students may feel free to contact a professor directly for information regarding a specific class. See FAU web site for course schedule. Final delivery format, location and instructor will be posted on the university course schedule.*

Guide to Higher Education Leadership rotation:

Required Courses for Master's degree and/or PhD.

- *Introduction to Higher Education* (EDH 6051) is offered fall semester (on Saturdays the first half of the semester or online) and spring semester (weekday or online). (This course does not count for the Ph.D and is for master's students only.)
- *Student Development Theory** (EDH 6040) is offered fall, spring and summer semesters in varied formats (weekday, Saturday, online/hybrid) *HEL students have the option of taking Lead I and/or Student Development Theory (EDH 6040) to satisfy the leadership core requirement.
- *History & Philosophy of Higher Education* (EDH 6065) is offered on Executive Fast Track Saturdays (2nd half of term) in fall and on weekdays in Boca Raton in spring. History & Philosophy is offered (odd years) alternating summers with Organization & Administration of Higher Education (even years)
- *Organization & Administration of Higher Education* (EDH 6635) is offered (weekdays) in fall and on Executive Fast Track Saturdays (First half of term) in Boca Raton in Spring. Organization & Administration is offered (even years) alternating summers with History & Philosophy of Higher Education (odd years).
- *Legal Issues in Higher Education* (EDH 7405) is offered fall semester (weekday).
- *Higher Education Business & Finance* (EDH 7505) is offered spring semester (weekdays in even years, Saturdays in odd years).
- *Doctoral Seminar in Higher Education* (EDH 7935) is offered fall semester on Saturdays the first half of the semester.

Experiential Learning

- *Higher Education Leadership Internship* (EDH 6941) is offered fall, spring, and summer semesters (Master's degree students)
- *NASPA Directed Conference* (EDH 6905) is offered spring semester (Master's degree students)
- *ASHE Directed Conference* (EDH 7905) is offered fall semester (Doctoral and master's degree students)
- *CSCC/AACC Directed Conference* (EDH 7905) is offered spring semester (Doctoral and master's degree students)
- *AERA Directed Conference* (EDH 7905) is offered spring semester (Doctoral and master's degree students)
- See schedule for other course options (such as Field Project, Internship, Action Learning) (Action Learning is for doctoral students)

- *Student Affairs Leadership* (EDH 6045) is offered in the fall (weekday).
- *International Comparative Higher Education* (EDH 6058) is offered in the spring.
- *Community College Curriculum* (EDH 6215) is offered in the summer (and sometimes spring).
- *Improvement of Instruction in College* (EDH 6305) is offered in the summer
- *Contemporary Issues in Student Affairs* (EDH 6367) is offered in the fall (weekday).
- Special Topics courses and seminars are offered occasionally. See course schedule.
