






Educator Preparation Completion Data








Teacher Preparation Completion Rates v. Initial Teacher Certifications

- Programs that underwent a second continued approval site visit have increased their average site visit score. This is an indication that their programs are improving based on the support and feedback provided through the continuous improvement process.
- Examinees in educator preparation programs continuously outperform non-program examinees in Florida Teacher Certification Examinations (FTCE).






Three-Quarters of Classroom Teachers Who Were Teaching 5 Years Ago Are Still In Florida Public Schools

VAM Ratings by Certification Pathways








Paraprofessionals: Slight Increase in 2023-24






Newly Hired Paraprofessionals






Teacher Departures Trend Analysis
