

Dr. Joseph M. Furner, Ph.D., is a Professor of Mathematics Education and Curriculum and Instruction in the Department of Curriculum and Instruction at Florida Atlantic University in Jupiter, Florida. He received his Bachelor's degree in Math Education from the State University of New York at Oneonta and his Masters and Ph.D. in Curriculum and Instruction and Mathematics Education from the University of Alabama. Dr Furner joined

Florida Atlantic University in 1996 as an Assistant Professor. In 2002, Dr. Furner was tenured and promoted to Associate Professor and, in 2013, to Professor. His scholarly research relates to math anxiety, the implementation of the national and state standards, English language issues as they relate to math instruction, the use of technology in mathematics instruction, math manipulatives, family math, and children's literature in the teaching of mathematics.
