





Causes & Characteristics of
Youth Suicide

Family

- Stressful events i.e. divorce, separation, death

- violence, sexual or physical abuse --3-6 times more likely to attempt suicide

- Interaction patterns characterized by anger, emotional ambivalence, and rejection are associated with self destructive behavior in young people

- Family member who commits suicide--up to 75% of children who were under age 11 when suicide of family member occurred attempted suicide during adolescence

\* 38% of adolescents who attempt suicide had close relative who committed suicide
