Biography

Dr. Victoria Brown, Associate Professor, contributes a vast array of teaching experience and knowledge in the area of instructional technology to the Department of Teaching and Learning (DTL) in Florida Atlantic University (FAU)'s College of Education (COE). She draws from her experience and knowledge to model how to apply instructional learning theory supported with technology, to promote high quality instruction maximizing learning outcomes in both K-12 and secondary classrooms. Dr. Brown joined the University in 2005 as Assistant Professor of the Department of Technology and Research, serving as Director of Instructional Technology from 2006 to 2007. In 2009, she became Assistant Professor, Teaching and Learning, and was promoted to Associate Professor in 2012. She is currently serving as Interim Assistant Provost of eLearning at FAU.

Dr. Brown teaches an undergraduate course in educational technology and graduate courses for teachers and instructional designers in instructional, courseware and web design. Dr. Brown partnered in the development of the master's program in Social Foundations: Instructional Technology combining instructional design and technology integration. She was a judge for the 2011 Outstanding Teacher of the Year bestowed by the Florida Society for Technology in Education. Dr. Brown has served on various FAU committees, including the Grade Review Committee from 2009-2010 and the Honor Code Development Committee from 2008-2010. Presently, she serves as Co-Chair of the Technology Council for the Society of Informational Technology and Teacher Education, an international organization.
