IV. Graduate Issues

A. Graduate Faculty Applications and Process

Action: Gail Burnaford- Level A Approved; Lydia Smiley, Level A Approved

- B. University Graduate Council Deborah Floyd reported about the University Graduate Council activities as follows:
 - a) The Graduate Governance Document has been sent out for another vote. Most of the changes the COE faculty requested have been made and the document is much better because of this input. All members are encouraged to read this document carefully because, if it goes into effect our COE GPC needs to ensure we are in compliance regarding various issues such as graduate faculty appointments for adjuncts. All faculty are encouraged to vote.
 - b) The Thesis and Dissertation Guide is being revised. Deborah Floyd distributed copies of clarifications being considered by the University Graduate Council and asked for input.
 - <u>Action:</u> Valerie Bryan and Mary Lou Duffy will chair a sub-committee to review the document and recommend revisions. Valerie Bryan will scan the changes distributed and send to COE GPC members for this input.. This will be on the next COE GPC agenda.
 - c) Masters Degree Comprehensive Examinations was discussed at the University Graduate Council level, but without much support for a university wide policy. This was an information item only and COE GPC faculty members noted that some programs have these exams and others do not; thus, this is a programmatic option that is desirable.
 - d) Thesis and Dissertation Electronic and Paper Publishing- The FAU library officials would prefer to not continue the process of collecting paper copies of thesis and dissertations. Information about electronic processes was distributed to the COE GPC.
 - <u>Action:</u> It was agreed that the COE GPC has no objection to moving toward electronic publishing of graduate thesis and dissertations as long as the requirement of a paper copy going to the supervising faculty member and the department stays in place.
 - e) Doctoral Completion Research Project Deborah Floyd distributed information about a research project regarding doctoral matriculation. She asked that the COE GPC review this research and consider the possibility of focusing on a discussion about our COE graduate programs in light of this research.

Action: It was agreed by consensus that this would be a good topic for a future meeting.

V. Student Petitions Subcommittee- This committee functioned as a "committee of the whole" for this meeting.
