information that reveals the nominee to be the kind of professional/school counselor who should be recognized for

achieving excellence.

<u>Documentation</u>: Candidates should present the following supporting materials:

1. Letter of support from supervisor/director, department chair, or colleague, describing the applicant's outstanding:

- demonstration of advocacy for clients/students
- service to clients/students
- exceptional record of outcomes with clients/students in quality of life, employment or situational adjustment
- Letter of support from a supervisor/director, department chair, or colleague with whom the applicant
 participated in a responsible role, employment agency, school-wide or within community, which distinguished
 him or her as an outstanding leader.
- 3. Resume or vita, including written statement describing advocacy activities and professional development activities and organizational membership or other creative endeavors.
