This is a competitive and selective process and not all proposals will be accepted. Group or individual submissions are welcome. Graduate and undergraduate students interested in presenting may submit proposals for review by the Symposium Committee by **Sept. 15, 2016**. Students whose proposals are accepted for presentation or posters session must attend the symposium.

- A completed proposal submission form on Survey Monkey. The SAC committee reserves the right to determine the number of presentations accepted. Poster materials and boards are not provided.
- A 400-word maximum, well-written abstract that includes: a brief description of the topic, methodology, current stage of research, and significance to the study and/or practice of education or another program within the College of Education. The abstract may be typed directly into the Survey Monkey submission form.
