EXPOSURE TO COVID-19	POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 OR SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19
<p>Vaccinated WITH <u>Current</u> Booster: Those who are fully vaccinated within the 5 months (or 2 months for J&J/Janssen) or fully vaccinated and have received a booster dose within 5 months, AND have come into contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19 will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Quarantine is not required. Continue to report to assigned work or classes unless you develop symptoms.• Be tested 5 days from the day of exposure.• If you test positive, follow the steps in the righthand column.	<p>Those who are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or have tested positive for COVID-19 will (<i>regardless of vaccine status</i>):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Do not come to work or class and contact your supervisor or faculty member if you will be absent from assigned work or classes.• Employees must use sick time unless remote work is authorized.• Cooperate with the contact tracing efforts of the Florida Department of Health if you are contacted.• If you have not been tested, test immediately.• If you are positive, Isolate at home for 5 days.• Be released from isolation following a negative test or completed entire 5 days of isolation and improved symptoms and fever-free for 24 hours.• End isolation after 5 full days following onset of symptoms or your positive test if you are fever-free for 24-hours (without fever-reducing medication) and your symptoms are improving.• Wear a mask around others for an additional 5 days.
<p>Unvaccinated or Vaccinated <u>WITHOUT</u> Current Booster Dose: Those who are not fully vaccinated or vaccinated >5 months ago (or 2 months for J&J/Janssen) AND have not received a booster dose within the past 5 months, AND have come into contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19 will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Not come to work and contact your supervisor or faculty member if you will be absent from assigned work or classes.• Employees must use sick time unless remote work is authorized.• Cooperate with the contact tracing efforts of the Florida Department of Health if you are contacted.• Quarantine at home for 5 days• Be tested at Day 5. If you test positive, follow the steps in the righthand column.• If you do not have a negative test result, wear a mask around others for an additional 5 days.• End quarantine after 5 full days after your day of exposure.
