ONLINE COURSE DESIGN



Need to design your new online course?

eDesign

Complete design and development of a course for first-time, online instructional delivery. During the eDesign process, faculty work one-to-one with an instructional designer to create a fully online course that aligns with state quality standards. Faculty provide subject matter expertise and course content to aid the instructional designer in developing their courses.

Stipend available for eligible faculty: \$4500 - \$6000

Need to update an existing course (3 or more years old)?

Course Design Update

Faculty work one-to-one with an instructional designer to update an existing online course according to state quality standards. Submission for Quality Matters review will be available following the redesign.

Stipend available for eligible faculty: \$1,500

Quality Matters (external review certification)

Faculty work one-to-one with an instructional designer to update and submit for review an existing online course that has been taught at least twice in a fully online format..

Stipend available to eligible faculty: \$1000

Teaching Online Orientation

This self-paced online professional development training covers the basic information needed to teach online. The course features ADA compliant syllabus templates, quality reviewed course templates, rubrics, student success tips, Canvas gradebook instruction, and resources for finding course design help. The course can be completed in approximately 4-6 hours via Canvas.

Stipend available for eligible faculty: \$100

Flex Online Teaching Orientation

This self-paced online professional development training covers the basic information needed to teach a flexible or blended online course. The course features tips for live class facilitation, communicating with students in a remote format, using the Canvas grade book for assignments, and tips/strategies for effective facilitation of flexible learning experiences. The course can be completed in approximately 4-6 hours via Canvas.

Teaching Assistant Basics for Online Courses

This self-paced workshop is a 6-module (6-hour) workshop for Teaching Assistants of all levels and includes the basics of facilitating and providing course assistance to instructors in online courses for any discipline. The course focuses on getting started with Canvas, navigating and setting roles, uploading and maintaining course content, creating assessments and grading, integrating media and technology within the course, identifying facilitation techniques for live sessions, and applying implementation strategies for FAU policies including academic integrity

Understand Canvas and want to dive deeper into the pedagogy of online teaching?

Teaching Online - Pedagogy and Practice

This self-paced workshop can be completed online or in a hybrid format in a recommended timeframe of 8 weeks. Faculty interact with peers as they complete 8 modules with practical application exercises covering topics such as writing objectives, assessment strategies for online learners, course module alignment, ADA compliance, copyright compliance, multi-media creation, active learning.
