International First-Time in College and Transfer Admissions Information

FOUR STEPS TO Apply

1.SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

Complete and submit the FAU Application (first time college students can also submit the Common App) and pay the non-refundable \$30 fee online. Visit fau.edu/apply-now.

2.TRANSCRIPTS

First-Time in College Students: Send high school records (including all grades, completed courses/subjects, and exam results including CXC/GCSES/etc.) to be evaluated by a NACES evaluation agency. FAU will only accept an evaluation conducted by a NACES accredited agency. Visit fau.edu/admissions/international/how-to-apply/

Transfer Students:

For all US institutions attended: Submit official transcripts. For all non-US institutions attended: Submit professionally NACES evaluated post-secondary coursework showing course-by-course evaluations for all subjects and grades.

Depending on the number of credits completed, transfer students may be required to meet freshman admission requirements.

3. TEST SCORES

SAT, ACT, or CLT scores are required for all first-time in college applicants AND transfer applicants with less than 30 post-secondary credits earned. Find SAT test information at collegeboard.com (FAU school code: 5229) and ACT test information at actstudent.org (FAU school code: 0729).

4. ENGLISH EXAMS

Students may be exempt from English Proficiency Exams if they meet the Florida Board of Governors requirements for college readiness through SAT or ACT sub-section scores in Verbal/Reading and English.

Scholarships

Latin American and Caribbean Scholarship Program

Approximately \$14,000 (in-state tuition equivalency) awarded annually to eligible Latin American and Caribbean students, plus a \$500 stipend per semester (available for the Wilkes Honors College, the College of Arts and Letters, and the College of Engineering & Computer Science).

President's International Freshman and Transfer Scholarship—\$24,000

Awarded \$6,000 annually and renewable for four years (freshman) or three years (transfer) for undergraduates on a student visa.
