TITLE: SELECTION AND APPROVAL OF EXTERIOR BUILDING COLORS

OBJECTIVE AND PURPOSE: To establish consistency with use of FAU color standards and oversight for overall campus color schemes among existing building elevations.

RESPONSIBILITY: ACTION

- COLOR REVIEW COMMITTEE** ♦ A committee made up of Assistant VP for Facilities, Director of Facilities Planning and Senior Project Manager shall review the recommended project elevation(s) for color choices.
- FP DIRECTOR/ SENIOR PROJECT MANAGER** ♦ Develop a minimum of three (3) schemes for review by the committee.
- ASSISTANT VICE PRESIDENT** ♦ Present the color schemes to building user (Dean, Administrator) for their input and priority of choices.
 ♦ Present preferred color scheme along with user comments to University Architect & VP of Facilities.
- UNIVERSITY ARCHITECT & VP FOR FACILITIES** ♦ Select final scheme for implementation.
- ASSISTANT VP** ♦ Forward approved color scheme to Director of Facilities Planning for pricing and implementation.
- SENIOR PROJECT MANAGER** ♦ Senior Project Manager to notify the building user (Dean, Administrator) as to the final color selection and timeline for implementing the work.
