PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project consists of site development and the design of a state-of-the-art 1,000 seat banquet facility and renovation of approximately 13,000 GSF of the existing Student Union entry, lobby and first floor support spaces. Project scope also includes development of plazas, exterior student gathering spaces and enhanced landscaping for the Student Union Complex. Design of the banquet hall is to provide maximum flexibility to accommodate various meeting room configurations and a variety of functions. The selected firm will provide program verification, site development, schematic design, design development, construction documents and construction administration for the referenced project.

The facility is to be designed and constructed to a minimum of LEED silver (or equivalent) standard.

The total Construction Budget is estimated at \$17.4 million.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Firms will be evaluated in the following areas: current workload, location, past performance, volume of state work, design ability, and experience and ability. Experience and ability scores will be based on the following criteria:

- 1. Experience of firm and individual members of the design team with project of similar size and program.
- Experience of firm and individual members of the design team in planning, programming, designing, estimating, and construction administration of projects similar in size and budget. Site examples of projects within the past five-year, including the ability to meet aggressive time and budget constraints.
- 3. Experience in campus planning, educational facilities, and working with committees.
- 4. Experience of firms with sustainable design.

- Design Approach and Method score range 0-20
- Ability to Provide Service score range 0-20
