PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project consists of program analysis, Master Planning, cost estimating and development of a site master plan for future phased construction of the elementary and middle schools; while the existing elementary, middle and high school facilities remain operational. Traffic flow analysis and rerouting of drop-off/pick up ques to alleviate current congestion is to be included in the site master plan.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Firms will be evaluated in the following areas: current workload, location, volume of state work, past performance, design ability, and experience and ability. Experience and ability scores will be based on the following criteria:

- 1. Experience of firm and individual members of the design team with project of similar size and program.
- 2. Experience of firm and individual members of the design team in planning, programming, master planning and cost estimating on similar projects. Site examples of projects within the past five-year.
- 3. Experience in campus planning, educational facilities and working with committees.
- 4. Experience in planning, programming, and designing K-12 and/or university laboratory schools.
