#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Projects included in the scope of this agreement will be specific for renovations, alterations, and additions that have a basic construction budget estimated to be \$2,000,000 or less, or studies for which the fee for professional services is \$200,000 or less. Services may be utilized on all FAU Campuses, special purpose centers/sites and instructional sites on an as needed basis.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

Firms will be evaluated in the following areas: current workload, location, past performance, volume of state work, design ability, and experience and ability. Experience and ability scores will be based on the following criteria:

- 1. Experience of firm and individual members of the design team with project of similar size and program.
- 2. Experience of firm and individual members of the design team in working with the State University System.
- 3. Evidence of efficient contact administration of projects.
