This form should be used by the person reported as "parent's spouse or partner" on the student's FAFSA. Your 2022 Federal Tax Information was successfully transferred to the student's 2024-2025 FAFSA. You must indicate the reason why you manually entered tax information which was different from what the IRS reported. The student will not be eligible for a financial aid disbursement until the required tax documents and this form are submitted and reviewed.
