HACU Scholarship Program: Fall 2022

Launch Date: September 23rd, 2022 | Application deadline: December 9th, 2022 We are still finalizing all details and logistics with our partners, but we anticipate launching our Fall 2022 cycle of scholarship opportunities on Friday, September 23rd, 2022. The Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities is pleased to be the administrator of scholarship opportunities provided by our partners to assist in defraying some of your college expenses. Scholarship opportunities will be added as they become available on our website. All scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Demonstrate financial need if required by the scholarship sponsor.
- Must meet specific criteria for the scholarship to which students are applying for.
- Students must currently attend a HACU-Member college or university in the U.S. or Puerto Rico at the time applications are completed and scholarships awards are made. Students transferring schools, the school must also be a HACU-member to be eligible to apply and receive your scholarship funds.
- Scholarships are only for enrolled college students. High School Students are not eligible to apply.
