Founded in 1969, The American University of Rome (AUR) is one of the oldest degree-granting American universities in Rome. AUR is an accredited university, which offers undergraduate degrees in eight disciplines and enrolls around 500 students a semester from over 40 countries. AUR is a private, nonprofit university committed to the promotion of cross-cultural exchange. On top of the Janiculum, Rome's highest hill, in a garden of Roman Pines, offering a spectacular view of the city and the surrounding hills, the campus is walking distance to Rome's historic center. Semester: Fall –Late August to late December

Spring –January 26 to July 1, 2017

Summer – May 30 to June 30, 2017 - Session I July 6 to August 2, 2017 - Session II

<u>Courses</u>: Italian Language/Culture and Cinema, Humanities, Anthropology, Art History, Business, Communications, Digital Media, International Relations, and Social Sciences.

<u>Academic Program</u>: Students elect up to 5 courses (16 credits). Courses are taught in English.

Accommodations: Students may elect for AUR to arrange housing on their behalf or may choose to make their own housing arrangements. Students electing university-facilitated housing are placed in furnished apartments in areas surrounding the university campus. Roman Apartment/Condominium "Casa Romana": Double occupancy bedrooms with 4-6 students/apartment. The apartments are located in traditional neighborhoods either within walking distance or a 15-35 minute public transit commute.

Program/Housing Fees:

Spring 2017 program – Est. \$8,450 (up to 5 courses), Housing Est. \$4,550 Summer 2017 program per session – Est. \$3,400 (up to 2 courses), Housing – Est. \$1,200

Program Fees Include: Tuition, accommodations, airport pickup, orientation session, computer lab, support from Student Life staff, and assistance with "permit to stay" process, library, campus medical visits, AUR application fee, transcript fee.

Program Fees do not Include: Airfare, FAU application fee (\$200 semester/\$250 year), CISI insurance (\$44/month), optional excursions, student visa, "permit to stay" (approx €195), meals (approx €900), transportation in Rome (approx €150), excursions (optional), textbooks/supplies (approx €750), and spending money.
