Eligibility and Requirements: Overall GPA of 2.75 or higher for undergraduate.

Program Dates:

- Fall: early September to late December
- Spring: mid-January to late April
- Summer: early June to mid-July

Course Offerings: Students take courses from UAB's "Pre-established Study Abroad Programs" which offers courses in the areas of Spanish language and culture, humanities, communication, business and economics, social sciences and art. Courses are taught at the central Barcelona campus of either Sant Pau or Eixample.

- Semester Tuition: est. €2,800 for 12 credits or est. €3,390 for 15 credits
- Summer Tuition: est. €900 for 3 credits or est. €1,500 for 6 credits
- Accommodations: est. €400 – 700 per month
- Education Abroad administrative fee at time of application (\$200 semester or summer/\$250 for year program)
- Mandatory CISI international health insurance (\$44/month)
- Airfare, meals, and personal spending money

Application Deadline:

- Fall: June 1 (course enrollment opens mid-March)
- Spring: November 1 (course enrollment opens mid-September)
- Summer: April 1 (course enrollment opens mid-February)
