The University of Northumbria, a leading British university, is a distinct combination of outstanding academic research and innovative programs, and social and cultural diversity. It is the largest University in the North East of England both at undergraduate and postgraduate level, and is located in the heart of Newcastle upon Tyne and Wear. The cost of living in Newcastle is among the lowest in England and has helped the city become a great location for students. The university campus offers students access to computer labs, library, cafeteria, recreation facility and more.

**Program Dates:**

- Fall (Semester 1): September 24, 2018 - January 25, 2019 (dependent on finals, mid-Dec. return may be possible)
- Spring (Semester 2): January 21, 2019 - May 31, 2019

**Eligibility and Requirements:** Open to undergraduate and graduate students in most majors. Required 2.75 overall GPA or higher for undergrad and 3.0 overall GPA or higher for graduate students.

**Courses Offerings:** Comprehensive offerings available in many subject areas. Students will take between 40-60 UK credits (12-15 US credits). Online course lists will change each term. Ask for a list of tentative courses if your term is not available online.

**Accommodations:** Northumbria offers a wide range of accommodations. These accommodations range from high end suites to traditional student housing in smaller standard rooms with shared living facilities. All accommodations are within walking distance of the university. Rent includes heat, light, hot water, basic possessions insurance, internet access, and support staff.
