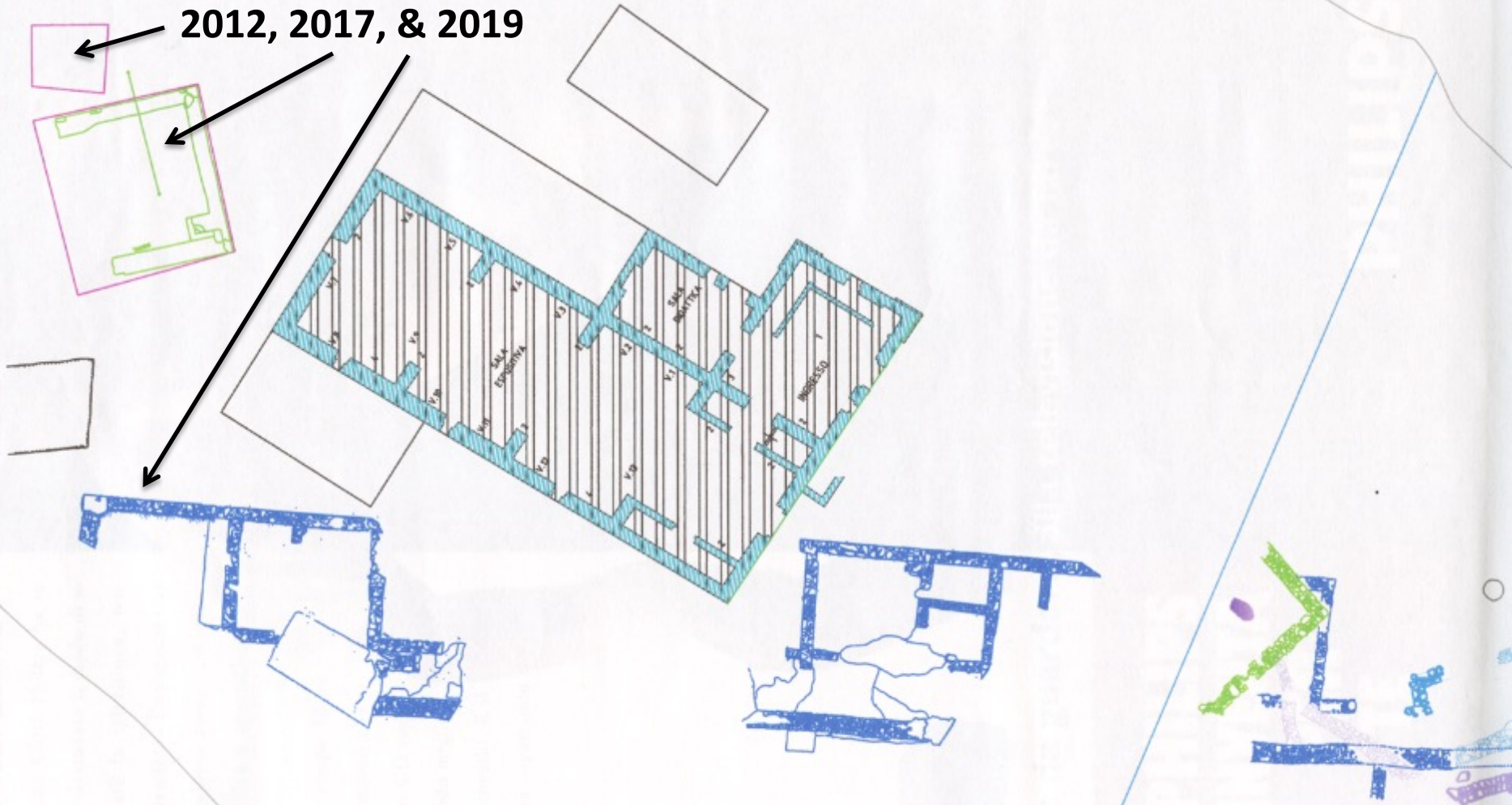

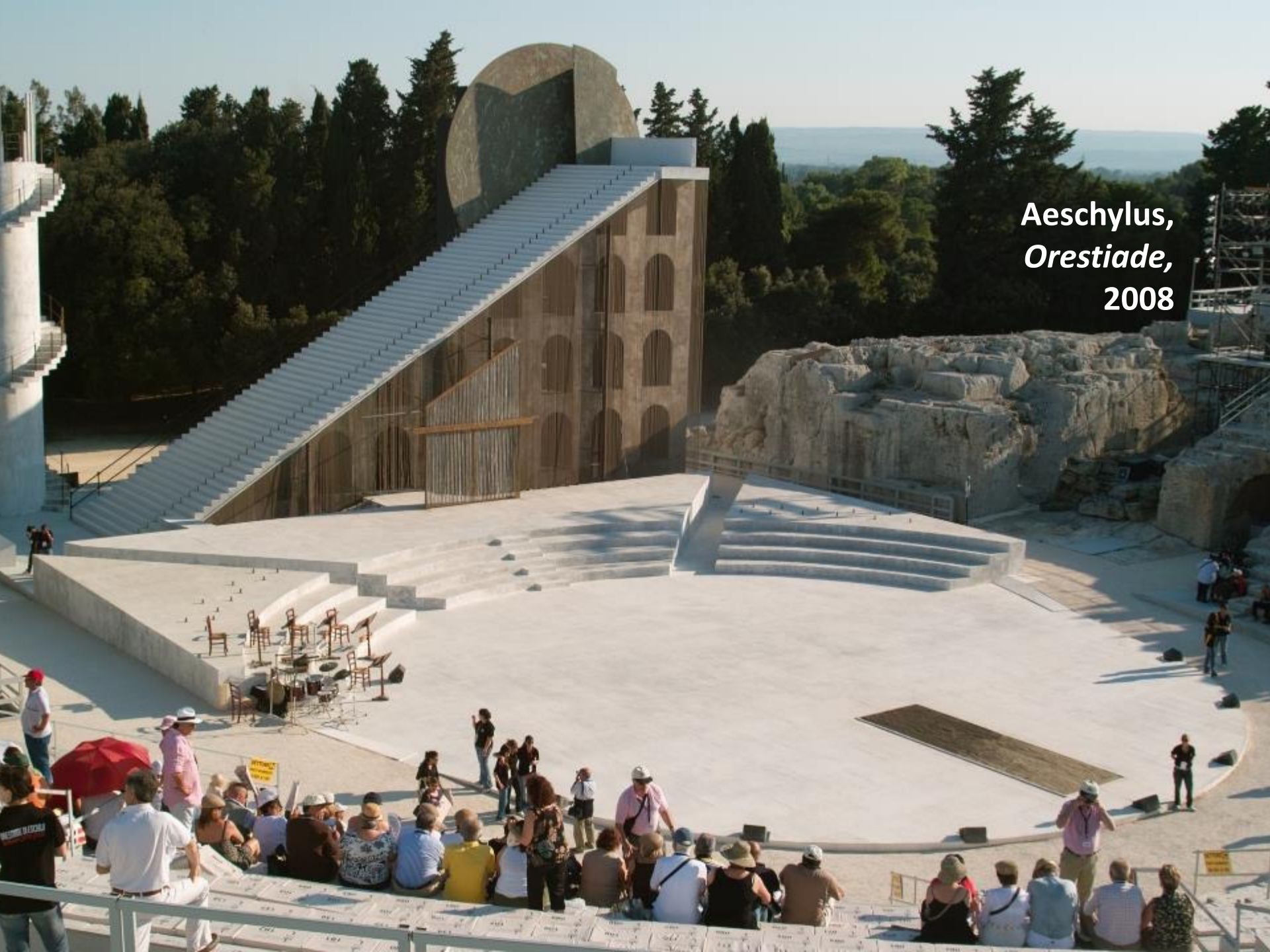

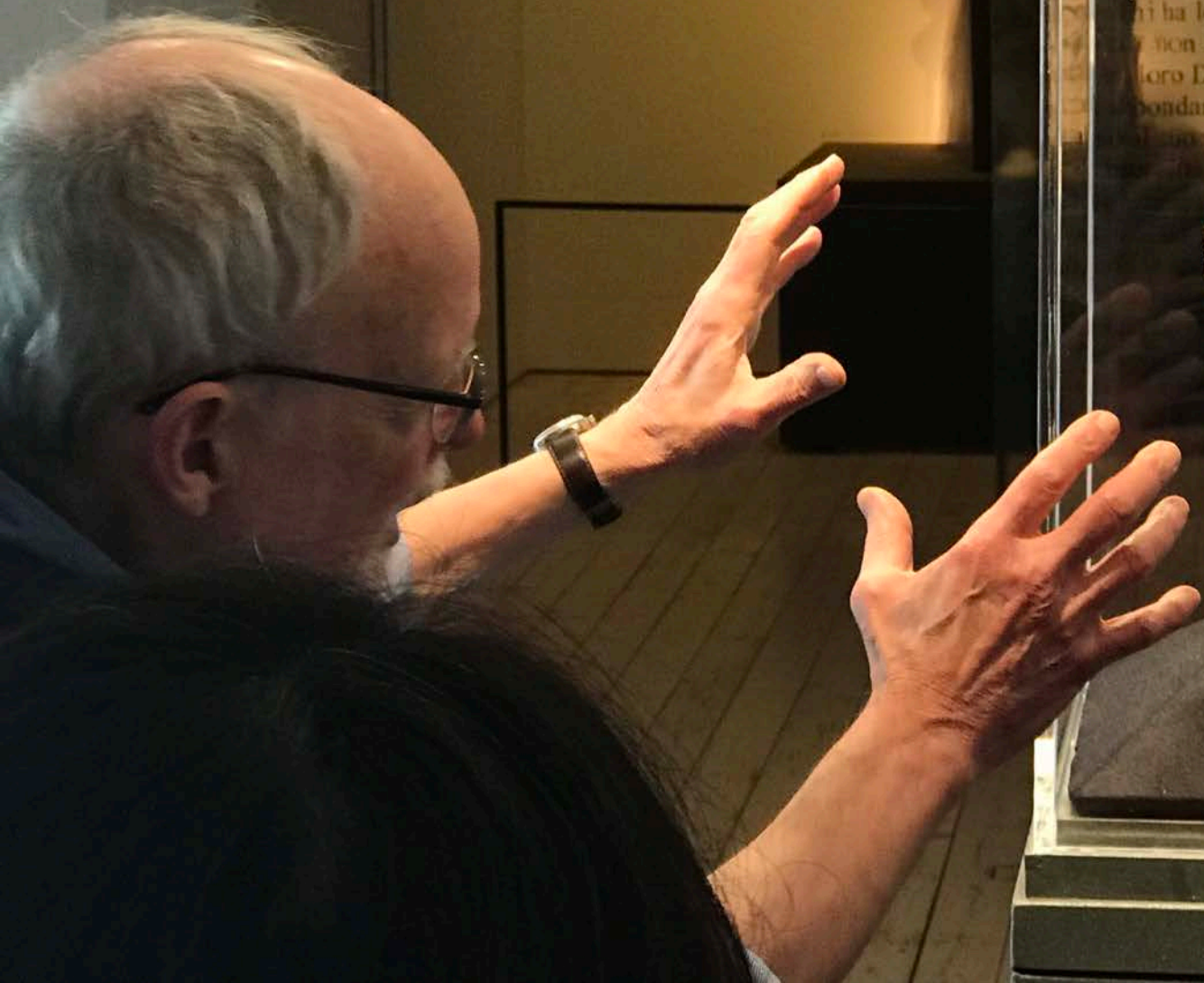

## Program Course Offerings:

- **ARH 2952** or **ARH 4957** Art History Study Abroad (3 credits) - *Required* for undergraduate students who are first-time program participants
- **ART 4905** Art History Directed Independent Study (3-4 credits)
- **ART 4906C** Directed Independent Study in Art (3-4 credits)
- **ART 1300C** Drawing Foundations (3 credits) *Req. Drawing Track or*
- **ART 4311** RI: Advanced Drawing (3 credits)
- **ARH 6913** Directed Independent Study - program course listing for graduate students (3-4) - *Required* for graduate students participating on the program for the first time.
- **ART 5930** Directed Area Studies in Art - special studio art oriented project (3-4 credits)

## Course Eligibility & Requirements:

Students participating on the program for the first time must take two required courses listed above for at least 6 credits. Students returning to participate for a second time may take one required course for 4 credits.



# Program Cost

**\$3,872.00 + tuition for the summer courses associated/required for the program**

## **Program Fee Includes:**

- Accommodations from check-in through check-out date with evening meals
- Transportation to and from the dig site
- Dig site supplies
- Program group meals
- Some museum visits

## **Program Fee Does Not Include :**

- \$200 Administrative fee paid at time of application submission
- International flight
- Tuition for courses/credits taken on program (FAU in-state and out-of-state rates apply)
- Passport cost
- Out-of-town meals
- Personal spending money
