Deadlines to Submit Documents for I-20

- Once you got admitted, you will receive a Welcome Email with instructions to submit a Request for I-20, a Certificate of Eligibility for Non-Immigrant Student Status.
- The <u>Financial Certification Form (FCF) or proof of funding</u>, is required for international applicants seeking to obtain immigration documents for international student status.

Medical Insurance

- All International students and scholars with F and J non-immigrant status in the United States are required to have health insurance that meets the Florida Board of Governor's requirements.
- International students will be routinely enrolled in the university-sponsored Student Health Insurance Program (SHIP), and the insurance premium will be charged to the student's FAU account.
- Each semester (usually one month prior to the start of the term) students will have the option to submit an alternate insurance waiver.
- To submit a waiver, go to www.insuranceforstudents.com/FAU. Tentative Deadline to submit waivers for Summer 2023: Tentative Monday, May 15, 2023 (11:59pm EST).

January 10, 2023, at 9 a.m.	Summer 3 term Housing contract is available for admitted first year students through the Owldone portal.			
March 1, 2023	Summer 1, 2 and 3 term housing contract is available for current students and new transfer students			
April 1, 2023	Priority deadline to complete a housing contract for newly admitted first year student. Admitted students must complete their tuition deposit prior to completing a housing contract. The housing contract will close when spaces have filled and a wait list will be available.			
May 14, 2023	Move-In Summer 1 & 2 term students from Noon – 4 p.m. Check-in directly at your assigned residential hall.			
June 22 – 23, 2023	Move-In Summer 3 Students must schedule a move-in appointment through the <u>Housing</u> <u>Portal</u> after they receive their housing assignment. Check-in directly at your assigned residence hall.			



Earliest Day & Last Day to Arrive for Summer 2023

- Students can arrive as early as 30 days before the program start date listed on your I-20. Students are **not permitted to enter the U.S. earlier than 30 days before the program start date.**
- Last day to arrive for Summer I (Full-term) Thursday, May 18, 2023
- Last day to arrive for Summer III (Second half of term) Thursday, June 29, 2023
- Only if you have received an assistantship appointment and have received support from your academic department, you may be approved for late arrival later the date above. Each late arrival request will be reviewed and decided case by case.
- To request Late Arrival Letter, you could submit a Letter Request Form.
