## INTERNATIONAL GRADUATE STUDENTS

The Financial Certification Form (FCF) is a required supplemental form for international applicants seeking to obtain immigration documents for international student status (I-20 for F-1 students and DS-2019 for J-1 students). The I-20/DS-2019 is a Certificate of Eligibility to obtain the F-1/J-1 visa. The Applicants may submit the FCF and supporting documents at any time during their admission process. The International Services (IS) office will issue the appropriate immigration documents only after the applicant (1) has been formally admitted to FAU, and (2) completed this form and submitted acceptable financial supporting documents.
