The grades of "C," "D+," "D," "D," "F" and "U" are failing grades, although the grade points associated with these letter grades are included in grade point average calculations. The new cumulative GPA above must be greater than or equal to 3.0. No credits are earned in courses in which grades of "AU," "CR," "F," "I," "U," "W," "WM" or "ZR" are received. Students who do not maintain satisfactory progress in their research, as determined by their thesis or dissertation advisory committee, may be dismissed should unsatisfactory progress continue in accordance with [Academic Dismissal of Students from a Graduate Degree Program](#) (2015 Provost Memorandum).
