### **CATALOG CHANGES**

# Current Catalog Language (1/22/24)

- The student must have a master's degree from an approved college or university.
- 2. The student must have a grade point average and Graduate Record Examination scores as follows:
  - a. An average of 3.5 or higher in all graduate work taken;
  - Minimum GRE scores of 148 (verbal), 144 (quantitative) and 3 (analytical writing).
- The student must have completed at least three years of full-time experience working with individuals with disabilities.
- 4. Each applicant for admission to the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degree in Special Education must be approved for admission by the department. This recommendation will in part be based upon an interview and a writing sample.

# Proposed Catalog Changes

- 1. The student must have a master's degree from an approved college or university.
- 2. The student must have a grade point average and Graduate Record Examination scores as follows:
  - a. An average of 3.5 3.0 or higher in all graduate work taken;
  - b. Undergraduate GPA of 3.0 in the last 60 credit hours
     Minimum GRE scores of 148 (verbal), 144 (quantitative) and 3 (analytical writing).
- The student must have completed at least three two years of full-time experience working with/supporting individuals with disabilities.
- **4.** The student must complete a personal statement describing their research/scholarly and academic interest, strengths, areas of growth. The template for the template can be seen here.
- 5. The student must select two FAU Department of Special Education faculty members as potential major professors (advisor, mentor). Applicants must complete a statement detailing their choices for major professor here.
- **6.** The student must complete an original writing sample. The timed writing sample is to be completed in person, under controlled conditions.

  Committee to complete the admission decision
  process.
