#### Catalog Course Description Changes for RED 6351, RED 6548, RED 6546, RED 6836

#### Reading Practicum (RED 6836) 3 credits

Prerequisite: RED <del>6548</del> ADD RED 6546

Supervised tutorial experience in working with children exhibiting special reading problems.

#### Reading Diagnosis (RED 6546) 3 credits

Prerequisite. RED 6351

A formal as well as informal diagnosis of reading problems in a clinical setting. An introduction to and writing of case reports is included.

#### Remedial Reading (RED 6548) 3 credits

Prerequisite: RED 6351

Detailed analyses of case studies in reading with primary emphases on theoretical and etiolog factors of reading disability. Classical remedial approaches are included.

#### Developmental Reading (RED 6351) 3 credits

# Prerequisite: LAE 4353

Course provides an advanced study of theory and practice related to developmental reading instruction. Emphasis is on theoretical considerations of basic reading skills using an interdisciplinary approach.
