I met with Dilys on Monday and we discussed CCEI's proposal that the Teacher Leadership Certificate be a track in the Master's of C&I.

I hope the following will clarify my position on behalf of the Department of Teaching and Learning.

The Department of Teaching and Learning believes that based on the nature of the degrees and programs that the two departments offer, there is program and degree overlap. The Department of Teaching and Learning's lack of support was meant to highlight this overlap, but not meant to stop the proposal. It is our belief that just because Teaching and Learning works with teachers, we acknowledge that other departments do as well. Therefore, it is further the perspective of Teaching and Learning that should this degree track move forward for approval through the university, the department would like it recorded that such approval would ALSO not prohibit the Department of Teaching and Learning from offering future master's degrees to teachers.

Teaching and Learning does not have a problem with the substitution of EDF 6637 for EDF 6800. Does this mean that EDF 6800 will no longer be offered? I ask because it is a course in a few of our master's degrees.

Unfortunately, the department of Teaching and Learning cannot support the Teacher Leadership certificate as a concentration of the M.Ed. As you might guess, the DTL see this as direct competition to the work that we do. While we understand that it is not certification, it is working with teachers and to have DTL excluded represents a lack of acknowledgement for the work that we do.
