 appropriate work in Women's Studies may be admitted on the condition that additional
 coursework in Women's Studies is completed in addition to the requirements for the M.A.
 degree.
- 2. Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA for the last 60 undergraduate credits attempted and competitive Graduate Record Exam (GRE) scores. Applications are accepted for the fall and spring terms only.
- 3. In addition to the University application, students must complete the application specific to Women, Gender and Sexuality Studies. The application is available at the <u>Center for Women, Gender and Sexuality Studies website</u>. This application includes the following requirements:
- a. The cover page, with student name and mailing information;
